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Information on the Abstract judging criteria

Formal requirements for abstracts prepared by conference applicants:

- Length: min 1800 characters max 3600 characters (including spaces)
- The title of the abstract should be the same as the title of the paper to be presented at the conference and should be thematically related.

Content requirements for the abstract - what needs to be written:

- Justification of the choice of topic, the purpose of the research, the originality of the topic,
- Description of the theoretical/literary background, materials/source base and methodology of the research,
- Formulation and statement of the research problem and/or hypotheses,
- Expected results, conclusions, long-term objectives.

Criteria for judging the abstract (Maximum 30 points):

Editing and style of the abstract (max 10 points)

- 0-2 points if the text describing the research and development activity is difficult to read, carelessly edited, with several formal errors,
- 3-5 points if the text describing the research and development activity is clumsy, cumbersome but carefully drafted,
- 6-8 points if the text presenting the research and development activity is of appropriate style and composition, with some minor errors due to carelessness,
- 8 to 10 marks if the text describing the research and development activity is well structured, smoothly written and error-free.

Theoretical/technical background of the research (max 5 points):

- 0-2 points if the text describing the research and development activity makes no or only a passing reference to the processing of literature,
- 3-5 points if the text describing the research and development activity makes a valuable contribution to the study of the literature on the subject, both at home and abroad.

Description of the materials/source base and methodology (max 5 points):



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- 0-2 points if the method is unsatisfactory, the author could have chosen a more appropriate method in the circumstances, the chosen sources/materials are not applicable,
 - 3-5 points if the method is up-to-date, reliable, effective, guarantees publishable work, and the source/materials examined are perfectly compatible with the method.

The aim of the research, the originality of the topic (max 10 points):

- 0-2 points the results projected in the abstract are self-serving and the problem is not relevant,
- 3-5 points results projected in the abstract are of professional interest,
- 6-8 points the results presented in the abstract are very novel,
- 9-10 points the results presented in the abstract make a major contribution to the development of the discipline, the work is suitable for presentation in a professional context.
